George School Parking Guidelines



Each vehicle that is registered with the Campus Safety Department should display a color-coded decal identifying their assigned parking area.

Decals are distributed from the Physical Plant Office (Ext. 6610)

All parking decals should be affixed to the upper inside corner of the front windshield on the passenger's side. Parking decals are not transferrable; each decal is vehicle specific.

The following departments will receive a **GREEN** decal for their vehicle(s). If you receive a green decal you are assigned to park in the *Marshall Center Lot or the Lower Lot near Grounds.* If both lots are full, you will be expected to park in the *Fitness and Athletics Center Lot*, designated for overflow vehicles.

ARTS DEPARTMENT:

All Arts Department staff are assigned to park in the <u>Walton Lot</u> and should display a LIGHT BLUE/YELLOW decal.

ATHLETICS DEPARTMENT:

All Athletics Department staff are assigned to park in either the *Fitness and Athletics Center Lot* or the *Alumni Gym Lot* and should display a LIGHT BLUE/YELLOW decal.

BROWN HOUSE/SMITH HOUSE/STREETZ HOUSE:

All Brown House dorm staff and Smith House/Streetz House residents are assigned to park in the **Brown House Lot** and should display a **LIGHT BLUE/YELLOW** decal.

CAMPBELL:

All Campbell dorm staff and residents are assigned to park in the <u>Campbell Lot</u> and should display a LIGHT BLUE/YELLOW decal.

DRAYTON/INWOOD:

All Drayton dorm staff, Drayton residents, and Inwood residents are assigned to park in <u>Drayton Circle</u> and should display a LIGHT BLUE/YELLOW decal.

Visitors' spaces are reserved from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., after which they may be used by residents for additional parking.

MAIN:

All Main dorm staff and residents are assigned to park in the *lot at the rear of Main Building and* should display a **RED** decal. Additional parking is available in the Lower Lot behind Westwood Dorm or the Marshall Lot.

MDA LIBRARY:

All library staff are assigned to park in the Fitness and Athletics Center lot and should display a **LIGHT BLUE/YELLOW** decal.

MIDWOOD AND NORTHWOOD:

All Midwood and Northwood residents are assigned to park in the <u>Midwood</u> spaces and should display a LIGHT BLUE/YELLOW decal.

ORTON:

All Orton dorm staff and residents are assigned to park in the <u>Orton Lot</u> and should display a **LIGHT BLUE**/**YELLOW** decal.

STUDENT HEALTH AND WELLNESS CENTER:

All Student Health and Wellness Center staff and residents are assigned to park in the <u>Student Health</u> <u>& Wellness Center spaces</u> and should display a **RED** decal.

TWIN HOUSE:

All Twin House residents are assigned to park in the <u>Twin House parking spaces</u> and will display a **LIGHT BLUE/YELLOW** decal.

Visitors' spaces are reserved from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., after which they may be used by residents for additional parking.

WESTWOOD:

All Westwood dorm staff and residents are assigned to park in the <u>Lower Lot</u> behind Westwood and should display a LIGHT BLUE/YELLOW decal.

<u>ALL OTHER CAMPUS RESIDENTS</u> should park in the allocated parking area at your residence and should display the appropriate decal for your housing unit. Additional parking is available in the Lower Lot behind Westwood Dorm, the Marshall Lot, or the Fitness and Athletics Center Lot.

ADMISSION VISITOR PARKING:

Admission visitors' parking spaces next to Sunnybanke are reserved from 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. **PLEASE REFRAIN FROM PARKING IN SPACES FOR ADMISSION VISITORS DURING THESE HOURS.**



PLEASE READ: PERSONAL PROPERTY DAMAGE

The insurance that George School carries does not cover losses on personal property. Damage to property that is caused by factors that are outside of anyone's control are deemed "acts of God" by insurance companies, and are not covered even under tenant's, homeowner's, or automobile insurance policies. Because George School is a heavily wooded campus, and our parking lots tend to be situated in wooded areas, damages to cars from high winds and falling branches are the most common types of damage in this category. During particularly windy days, employees are encouraged to take the precaution of moving their cars away from wooded areas, and to park in areas such as in the parking lot next to the Fitness and Athletics Center.
